Household Garbage

Please remember:

- ☑ Garbage should <u>not be in cans</u>, but placed in plastic bags at the end of your driveway no earlier than the night before your designated pickup day.
- ✓ All garbage should be placed in sealed, standard 20-30 gallon trash bags each bag weighing no more than forty (40) pounds.

Please refrain from leaving trash out on undesignated collection days.

Please wrap broken glass or other sharp objects in newspaper and try to place them where they cannot cause injury.

Tree Limbs and Yard Waste - Wednesday Only

- ☑ Excess tree limbs/branches may not exceed 3 to 4 feet in length.
- ☑ Please bundle and tie such items and place them at the end of your driveway.
- ☑ Lawn clippings and similar yard waste is to be placed in bio-degradable bags.

Cardboard Boxes

☑ Please flatten all cardboard boxes.

Hazardous Materials

- ☑ Items such as paint, oil, lawn, pool chemicals, tires, and hypodermic needles should not be included with household garbage.
- ☑ Throughout the year, Marion and Sumter Counties offer "Amnesty Days" at designated locations and times where these items may be delivered. Residents are required to deliver these and any other hazardous materials to these designated collection sites.
