- E. WATER AND SEWER RATE INDEXING
1. The water and sewer rates, as provided herein, shall be adjusted annually by the Board of Supervisors, as part of the annual budget preparation process, to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index- All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average, All Items, Base Period 1982-1984=100 (Series ID: CUUR0000SA0), Not Seasonally Adjusted, for the months April to April, as published by the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The base month for beginning the series shall be April 2007. The adjustment shall be proportional to the percentage increase in the index from the base index to one year from said date and the subsequent one year period thereafter. In the event of a change in the index, by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, the succeeding index as identified by the Bureau of Labor Statistics shall be used. Each adjustment shall be in effect for the intervening one year period, beginning October 1 of each year following the ending month of the adjustment period. Any adjustment shall be incorporated into the ensuing fiscal year budget and made a part of the advertisement for public hearing for said budget.
 2. This section of the Rule applies to the current system of the Village Center Community Development District (District) and any additional systems acquired by the District.
