Sumter County will host a public outreach meeting to present an overview of the County's ongoing Vulnerability Assessment study. This study will evaluate Sumter County's vulnerability to flooding and hazards, which will incorporate past occurrences, current conditions, and future projections to provide evidence-based recommendations for enhancing disaster preparedness, response and recovery.

During the meeting, the County will review the study's background, goals and scope. The public will be given the opportunity to provide input, offer insights on flooding and other issues to be considered, and identify critical assets important to the community.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 10, 2024, at 5 p.m. at the Wildwood Community Center, located at 6500 Powell Road, Wildwood.
