GENERAL RULES

- The Recreation & Parks Department will oversee all operations, scheduling and use of the fire pits. Only authorized, trained staff are allowed to operate the fire pit.
- Any individual with a valid Villages ID or guest with a valid guest ID card may visit the fire pit.
- Avoid flammable clothing (such as nylon) or any loose fitting clothing.
- Keep children and pets at least 3 feet away from the fire.
- Burning of trash or other materials is prohibited.

- Roasting or cooking of any kind without Recreation & Parks Department permission is prohibited.
- BYOB applies; kegs and glass containers are prohibited.

RESERVATIONS & USAGE

- Clubs/Residents wishing to reserve a Fire Pit must submit an Outdoor Specialty Facility Application a minimum of two weeks prior to the date requested.
- All participants must sign a Recreation Activity Release form.
- Reserved Fire Pit will not exceed 3-hour time limit.
- Only one reservation will be allowed each day. If the Fire Pit is not reserved, use is on a first come, first served basis.
- Saving seats is not permitted; however, additional personal seating is allowed.
- For further information contact the recreation facility or Recreation Administration.

The Recreation & Parks Department reserves the right to alter and/or modify these guidelines at any time to effectively manage facility operations and to continue to provide enjoyable, excellent lifestyle programs.
