

In an effort to preserve the beauty of our community, we are pleased to provide you the most up-to-date information on trash collection in The Villages.

Household Garbage

- Garbage should not be in cans, but instead put in plastic bags at the end of your driveway no earlier than the night before your designated pickup day.
- All garbage should be placed in sealed, standard 20-30 gallon trash bags, each bag weighing no more than forty pounds.
- Please refrain from leaving trash out on undesignated collection days. Please wrap broken glass or other sharp objects in newspaper and try to place them where they cannot cause injury.

Tree Limbs & Yard Waste — Wednesdays Only

- Tree limbs or branches may not exceed four feet in length.
- Please bundle and tie such material and place them at the end of your driveway.
- Lawn clippings and similar yard waste should be placed in biodegradable bags.

Cardboard Boxes

- Please flatten all cardboard boxes.

Hazardous Materials

- Items like paint, oil, lawn or pool chemicals, tires and hypodermic needles should not be included in your household garbage.
- Several times a year Marion & Sumter Counties hold "Amnesty Days" at designated locations where hazardous materials can be dropped off. Residents are required to take the listed materials and any other hazardous materials to these designated collection sites.

Recyclable Materials Guidelines

Materials Accepted:

- Clear plastic bags only
- Aluminum food and beverage containers
- Glass food and beverage containers:
brown, clear or green
- Ferrous (iron) cans
- PET plastic containers with the symbol #1:
narrow neck containers only
- HDPE natural plastic containers with the symbol #2:
narrow neck containers only (milk & water bottles)
- HDPE pigmented plastic containers with the symbol #2:
narrow neck containers only (detergent, shampoo,
bleach bottles, etc.; without caps)
- Plastics with symbols #3, #4, #5, #6, #7:
narrow and screw top containers
- Newsprint, magazines, catalogs
- Old corrugated cardboard
- Cereal boxes
- Telephone books
- Printed paper
- Copier paper
- Mail
- All other office paper without wax liners

Materials NOT Accepted:

(including but not limited to)

- Microwave trays
- Mirrors
- Window or auto glass
- Light bulbs
- Ceramics
- Porcelain
- Unnumbered plastics
- Plastic bags
- Coat hangers
- Glass cookware or bakeware
- Household items such as cooking pots or small
appliances
