

## ORDINANCE NO. 01-29

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 00-06, AS AMENDED, TO AMEND THE BOUNDARY OF THE VILLAGE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 4; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on March 7, 2000, the Marion County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 00-06 establishing the boundaries of the Village Community Development District No.4; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 4, 2001, the Marion County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 01-22 expanding the boundaries of the Village Community Development District No. 4; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of The Village Community Development No. by petition dated October 15, 2001, petitioned the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, to hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering an amendment expanding the boundaries of the District No. 4 by approximately 1.6 acres and a copy of such petition is on file with the Marion County Planning Department, now therefore

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida:

**SECTION 1. DISTRICT BOUNDARY AMENDMENT.** The Board hereby approves the petition to amend the boundary of the District by approximately 1.6 acres. The legal description of the District after this amendment is contained in Attachment One attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2 SEVERABILITY.** If any provision or portion of this ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, then all remaining portions and provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** A certified copy of this Ordinance as enacted shall be filed by the Clerk of the Board with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida within ten (10) days after enactment, and this Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with Section 125.66(2), Florida Statutes.
