

CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Go to DistrictGov.org and navigate to the Recreation page under the Department tab feature

- Click the box that reads "Click Here to Register for Recreation Events & Activities".
- · Find and click on the "Create an Account" button.
 - If you think you already have an account & are unable to log in, click on the "Forgot your password/ login name" to follow those steps. A message will pop up if you already have an account under that email address.
- Follow the prompts on the screen to complete your Resident account. All information should be under the Resident including name, address & phone number.
- You will receive an automated confirmation email that has to be verified before trying to log into your new account. Check the junk & spam folders if you don't see the email pop up in your general inbox.
- Click on the "Activate Now" button to verify and activate your account. You are now ready to complete the registration process!



Registration for weeks 1-4 begins today, Thursday, May 16th, and Thursday, June 20th, for weeks 5-9. Don't delay, online registration opens at 8:30 am on both days!

SAVING WATER

INDOORS

Tips



Watch out for silent leaks in toilets. Remove the toilet tank lid and any colored cleaning agents. Flush to clear the water in the bowl. Add dye tablets, leak detector fluid or even a few drops of food coloring to the tank. If there is a leak, color will appear in the bowl within 10 to 15 minutes. Flush when the test is completed.



Take shorter showers and make sure there are no leaks in showerheads. If there is a leak, make sure the showerhead is screwed tightly. Additionally, make sure showerheads are low-flow. Older high-volume showerheads deliver 4 gallons of water per minute. Pressures have been adjusted to the low flow fixtures to deliver as good a shower as the higher flow showerheads.



Adjust wash cycles for laundry. Select the minimum volume of water required for each load. Normal and permanent press wash cycles use more water, so use the shortest wash cycle for light loads. Stains can be pretreated to avoid rewashing.

If you believe you have a potable water leak, contact Utilities Customer Service at 352-750-0000 and they can review your billing history. Potable water conservation is a community-wide effort, we all share in the Stewardship of this valuable resource.

Village Community Development Districts 1 – 11

If you live in Districts 1 – 11 located in Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, there will be normal residential sanitation collection on Monday, May 27, 2024.

Village Community Development District 12, the Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney, and District 15

If you live in Village Community Development District 12, the Village of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney, and District 15, there will be no sanitation schedule change due to the holiday.

Village Community Development District 13 (excluding Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney) and District 14

If you live in Village Community District 13 (excluding Village of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney) and District 14, there will be no residential sanitation collection on Monday, May 27, 2024. Sanitation collection will be on Thursday, May 30, 2024.

If you live in the **Town of Lady portion of The Villages**, there will be no residential sanitation collection on Monday, May 27, 2024. Sanitation collection will be on Thursday, May 30, 2024.

If you live in the **Lake County portion of The Villages** (not including VCDD No. 11 and 14), there will be no sanitation collection on Monday, May 27, 2024. Sanitation collection will be on Tuesday, May 28, 2024. All collection days for the week will be moved to the next day.

If you live in the **Middleton Community Development District**, there will be no sanitation schedule change due to the holiday.

Guest ID Services

Guests of Villages' residents whose home address is outside Lake, Sumter, and Marion Counties are eligible to use selected Villages' resident amenity-supported recreational facilities. An original Villages Guest ID Card is required for all guests one (1) year of age and older. Guest ID Card Services are available 7 days a week: Monday – Friday 8:30am – 5pm: District Customer Service and all At You Service Centers (Paradise, La Hacienda, Savannah, Mulberry Grove, Laurel Manor, Lake Miona, Colony Cottage, SeaBreeze, Eisenhower, Rohan, Fenney, Everglades and Ezell); Saturday and Sunday 8:30 am – 12 pm: La Hacienda, Lake Miona, Eisenhower, Rohan and Everglades At You Service Centers Only.



For a more enjoyable experience, when visiting any swimming pool, take time to read the signs and become familiar with the Recreation & Parks Department Guidelines. Posted next to each phone is all the necessary information needed in case of an emergency (center name, address, phone number and county).

The Amenity Authority Committee advises the Village Center Community Development District on matters relating to Amenity Facilities, Amenity Fees and Services related to Amenity Facilities and Amenity Fees north of CR 466.

For additional information or if you are interested in having your name placed on the ballot for the 2024 Landowner Elections to become the representative for your District, you must complete the Official Statement of Eligibility for the Amenity Authority Committee and submit it to the District Clerk's Office between May 17, 2024, through June 14, 2024. Applicants must be a landowner and a resident of the District they are interested in representing.
