Subject:

Paradise Regional Recreation Center Rebuild - Survey Data Update

ISSUE:

Status update regarding Paradise Regional Recreation Center.

BACKGROUND:

District Staff received approval from the Amenity Authority Committee and the Village Center Community Development District during their August 2022 board meetings to begin the Capital Improvement Plan of a complete demolition and rebuild of a new upto-date Paradise Regional Recreation Center.

Staff designed and developed, with AAC input, the Paradise Regional Recreation Survey. It was reviewed and presented at the September 2022 AAC meeting. In addition, the survey was made available online at DistrictGov.org and all recreation centers beginning October 3, 2022. Notices were also posted at respective media outlets and postal stations. The survey portion of this capital project concluded on October 28, 2022.

Staff has included a survey summary for the committee's review and comment. Staff will continue to compile the survey data and input along with the existing amenities to be considered during the discussion, design, and planning of the conceptual Capital Improvement Plan of Paradise Regional Recreation Center. This survey information, along with current utilization, participation, costs, available land, maintenance, and operational support, will be used as part of the planning process to help determine the recreation amenities that best meet the programming needs for a sustainable new center.

The Paradise Regional Recreation Center Capital Improvement Project continues to progress; staff will coordinate with the property management team, designers,

architects, and engineers for the next steps and timelines in the planning, designing, and permitting of this project, including additional public meetings to review the conceptual site plan. District Property Management anticipates developing and presenting conceptual plans based on resident and committee input and direction in February or March 2023. DPM will commence with detailed design development upon consensus and approval of conceptual plans.

Staff will continue communicating with the committee and the public via various media outlets and public meeting updates concerning recommendations and progress as this capital project comes to fruition.







No one checks IDs so it's easy for anyone to enter the gate to the pool. We also think this is one of the most beautiful recreation centers in the Villages with the columns and the architecture. We would love to see it upgraded, not completely removed and rebuilt. It's all beautiful now, we don't want to see it rebuilt unless it's definitely going to be even nicer.

As someone who teaches an aerobics class at Mulberry Grove rec center (Americana room with the stage) I would HIGHLY recommend ceiling fans. We do NOT have them and the room gets very warm when doing physical activities.

As you know, the Florida sun is hard on people and facilities. I have learned that you can dramatically extend the life of equipment and facilities by installing a roof. It also makes the facility more popular and useful for a nominal cost. I would like to see a roof installed over at least one pickle ball court as a test. The game of Pickleball does not usually require lobbing the ball very high because of the small court size. I believe it will be the most popular Court in The Villages.

How about something different like a lazy river vs another pool? I've heard many villagers commenting on how fun a lazy river would be (need to allow inner tubes for floating down the river). I think this would be a very popular attraction. Also as a regional rec center a sports pool is needed. Much ad I live resort style pools a rectangular pool is best for organized activities like Wvb, water aerobics etc. if the pool will be open until 11 having games or classes under the lights will be popular.

I am a founder member of The Villages Gem & Mineral Society (2009). It is a very active group at Seabreeze. The biggest problem has always been a serious lack of safe storage for machines and members' products. Also by limiting access to our \$30,000 -\$40,000 investment in equipment to only 2 days (Thursday evening and Sunday morning) is such a shame as we need to set up time-tables limiting access for usage. We need more time available for this kind of activity and more space to store the equipment. We now have 2 Woodworking Centers open 7 days a week and rarely is there a need to 'ration' access to machines - in fact they are generally underused.....even when there was only one Center.

I am copying James W's original post HIS sentiments parallel my own. For those who enjoy the paradise pool as it is rebuild the recreation center with a courtyard pool like it is today where either buildings or fauna enclose the pool providing shade for those in the pool during certain hours of the morning rescan cancer prevention and wind prevent protection during the cooler months. Also keep the rectangular pool like we have and have it as a deep water pool for the reasons in regard to the circulation of the water for the heat and finally save the oaks save the oaks. If the pool is put where the shuffleboard courts courts are those trees will have to be removed so please please please do not do that and keep it as it is thank you. SAVE THE OAKS KEEP THE POOL PROTECTED RE SHADE /SUN AS IT IS NOW. ALSO DEEP WATER POOL SAVE THE OAKS

I like the idea of having the pool with a graduated entrance. It's nice to be able to lay in a little bit of water to stay cool.

I love the L-shape at Paradise pool. The placement of the jets also gives a great spa feeling without the yucky hot tub. This allows for walkers AND swimmers all at the same time without one interfering with the other as happens with most other pools. Sometimes things can get a little "cranky" in these situations. I know there are pools for lap swimmers but some don't want to (or can't) use them, because they are non-resident or too young) so everyone ends up on top of one another fighting for their personal space and this leads to @#\$%. Not a good way to start a day. This is totally avoided by the L-shape and roping off as at Paradise Pool. I also would hope none of those beautiful native trees with the moss are to be removed for whatever reason. That would be a sin. I fear that to accommodate a pool closer to the lake and to avoid leaves/pollen in the pool, the trees will be a problem and when the Rec Center buildings are combined, there will be no more protection against the trash without getting rid of the trees. Is there another solution? I am also not looking forward to sharing a pool with wandering crocs or flying golf balls away from protection of the Rec Center area. First Responders has a Resort style. Let Paradise have its L-shape back. I also love the Mark Twain Library and love to see the patrons ocoooh and aaaaah when they come in (Yes. I am a volunteer - 3 shifts). Hoping not much will change on this front. We like the non-techy part of it. It is the charm of the place that makes it so special and welcoming. The patrons and volunteers love it. I loved the old pool there because of its depth and I could actually swim in it and not deal with the constant walkers and kids hitting you all the time, in the pool. Walkers should be made to use the sports pools as their depth is so low. It was quite a serene pool and the meditative/healing properties of it were the greatest part about it. More healing, less rambunctious activities. Some of us Villagers are healing from major illnesses or accidents. None of the activities here focus on this group of people.

I really like the pool we have now - it has a good mix of depths - and our visitors love it too; a similar pool would be great The Rec Center has many lovely established trees - I hope we won't lose them to the construction. The Arts and Craft room is seriously short on storage space - may more space be factored into the new design please.

Enclosed by either buildings or shrubbery, it provides an oasis of shade for those in the pool at various times of the day, and it blocks off the cold winter winds, that allow for extra usable pool days, when Resort or Kidney Pools that are left in the open, provide no protection from the unblocked cold winter winds. Another feature of our current Courtyard Pool, is that our circulation system (and heating jets) come out of the side of the pool, instead of the bottom. The circulation jets provide more efficiency in providing heat throughout the pool, as we enter these colder fall, winter and spring months. The current Paradise Pool is also the only deep pool remaining in The Villages. This is a feature that is appreciated by morning swimmers, and afternoon grandkids, who like to jump into the pool. We need to continue the legacy of our Paradise Pool, and surround it with building (if we have to a single building design) and fauna. It will make it unique and the treasure that it is today. Another big concern is the loss, and threat of loss, of many mature oak trees on the east and northeast side of the property. If a pool is placed in the back where the shuffleboard courts are currently located, the leaves of these mighty oaks would be a constant problem for pool maintenance. As a result, they will probably be eliminated. So many people enjoy the shade and beauty that these trees provide. During COVID many a group who had their programs and clubs cancelled, met under these trees, especially during the summer months, as in some cases, they still do today. Paradise Pool and the mighty oaks in back, are what make Paradise Recreation Center special. Turning them into a parking lot, open air, Resort or Kidney pools would be a setback for our Historic Side of The Villages. But that seems to be the trend, with the dismantling of our Spanish Spring Town Square, and Rialto Theater, along with the closing of Katle Belle's and the Hacienda Country Club. Like I said, at the beginning, it was disappointing to see that a Courtyard Pool wasn't even an option in this survey. Like everything else, we all know that this whole project is already decided. This is a \$20 million investment, that nobody is excited about, only fearing what It would be great to have 12 shuffleboard covers so the villages could host tournaments. Library: more shelves and 2 more computers It would be fantastic to have a pottery area at Paradise Rec Center. The addition of potters' wheels and a slab roller would be well used! It would be nice if the ladders in the pools were longer, reaching further toward the bottom. It is difficult for the elderly to raise their legs up to the existing rungs.

It would be nice to have a zero entry pool such as at Fenney

It would be nice to keep the pool in the middle of the building. That is always really great on windy days, especially as open as that area is. Also like it is a deep pool.

Our patrons have already begun asking how they can continue to find the books they love during this time. To help fill this need, I propose the establishment of a Mark Twain Mini Library in each Regional Recreation Center. The basic rectangle layout of current pool at Paradise is ideal for residents and their guests, particularly with small children - there is a good area for children and good area for adults. A Kidney resort pool, albeit pretty, would be less functional for really swimming and children and family play. Thank you for your consideration.

The biggest drawback to TV compared to other retirement communities is the lack of a truly resort style pool. The trade off is a lot of ho-hum, no big deal pools to get you wet and a lot of golfing. Obviously, we chose TV and after all these years continue to choose it. But every time we visited friends with "luxury" pools we thought about it. And when we enthusiastically show friends the squares, golf courses, etc., we avoid showing any pools except Orange Blossom. We did join and use the Hacienda CC pool for a year. It had a tiki bar and food could be ordered, but it was NOT luxurious and not worth the extra money. Pools in TV make this a good retirement for the masses of people on lower fixed retirements. But we find it a hard sell for upper middle class friends. Just one TRULY resort pool would do so much to raise the image of TV and contribute to the enjoyment of so many people. The building is structurally sound therefore I don't see the need to replace it, just renovate.

The current Paradise pool is unique in The Villages. Please don't change its format. Also, Please keep the pool operating hours. "If it ain't broke don't The First Responders had inside basket ball shooting, I would love that.

The most desirable aspect of the existing pool is the very wide steps. They provide a place for very young children to play without going over their head The outdoor amenities are the ones listed in addition to those that are in close proximity to the current Paradise Recreation Center? If so I see no reason to duplicate them and spend additional funds.

The pool at the first responders recreation center is a joke! Who likes looking at a concrete wall? The AAC spent 8 million dollars to provide golf cart access to Soulliere Villas, you think they would have least provide a family pool with a view! Don't make the same mistake again.
