AMENDING THE DISTRICT RESOLUTION COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025 FOR HURRICANE DEBRIS MONITORING AND REMOVAL

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Fiscal Year 2024-25 Budget; and,

WHEREAS, debris monitoring and removal services were procured in order to complete the removal of debris district-wide; and,

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2024, Hurricane Milton made landfall in Florida which resulted in approximately 1,145 cubic yards of debris that needed to be removed; and,

WHEREAS, the total expenses that are the responsibility of Village Community Development District Number 6 totaled \$54,066.25; and,

WHEREAS, the budget needs to be amended in the amount of \$54,067 to cover the cost of debris monitoring and removal within the District; and,

WHEREAS, the District has submitted an application for FEMA Reimbursement for the total costs incurred for this storm event; and,

WHEREAS, the request to amend the Fiscal Year 2024-25 budget has been reviewed and approved by the District Manager.
