# Chapter IV Towing and Removal of Vehicles and Vessels from Private Property

VCDD No. 4 – Resolution 2025-05

Important Policy Update - Effective Immediately

The Villages Community Development District No. 4 Board of Supervisors has adopted Chapter IV Rule and Resolution 2025-05 which is a comprehensive vehicle parking and towing policy to maintain the safety, accessibility, and proper use of Temporary Overflow parking areas and District-owned property and roadways.

Effective March 14, 2025, vehicles parked in violation of established guidelines may be subject to towing. Violations include parking in unauthorized areas, blocking intended property use, parking inoperable vehicles, displaying expired registration, or creating nuisances through noise, obstruction, or other disturbances.

Tracts established for temporary parking within Village Community Development District No. 4 are depicted in a Unit's plat.

Temporary parking for the below listed Villa Units is not for the Owners' use but for the use of the Owners' Invitees and Guests within the Villa for temporary vehicular parking:

Villages of Marion – Villa Phillips (Unit 232)

Villages of Marion – Villa Soulliere (Unit 233)

All District-owned Roadways

The District will provide a 48-hour notice before vehicle removal, in accordance with Florida Statute 715.07. Improperly parked vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

Residents are advised to review this policy carefully and communicate these guidelines with all household members and guests.




To maintain the integrity of the executive golf courses and to provide the best play experience possible, Sarasota and Palmetto Golf Course will be closed for one day each.

### **Age Requirements**

Visiting children, with valid guest Id cards, must be 13 years of age and accompanied by an adult, at all times, to use the air gun, archery, billiards, croquet, lawn bowling, dog park facilities and game rooms. Valid guests must be 19 years of age to use the Fitness Clubs open.

### **Personal Items**

Leaving personal items at Recreation Facilities (Recreation Centers, Fit Clubs, Dog Parks, etc.) is not permissible unless approved through Recreation Administration. Any personal items that are left at Recreation Facilities will be removed by staff and discarded after a month. Residents and guests are required to remove any of their personal items.



# What is a Precautionary Boil Water Notice?

A major component of service provided by the District's Utilities Department is the risk involvina assessment waterborne contaminants through natural or man-made means. It is our responsibility to provide guidance and assistance to prevent exposure to drinking water contaminants that could present a threat to our resident's health. Water suppliers are required by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) to notify customers to boil water when conditions exist that may cause the water supply to be vulnerable to the potential for contamination. A Precautionary Boil Water Notice (PBWN) is a form of notification that advises customers to boil tap water used for drinking. cooking, and ice-making until tests the safe. verify water is The determination that the water is safe is a process through which the Utility Operations and Maintenance Contractor sends water samples to a State Certified Water Testing Lab and receives a report back, usually after 48 hours, stating that the water samples meet all federal and state regulations.

The precautionary boil water notice would then be rescinded by notifying all affected residents. An incident that requires a PBWN may include a water, wastewater or irrigation incident that could develop as a result of, but not limited to, a water line break, a problem at a water plant, a new connection to an existing line, a sewer back up, a Wastewater Treatment Plant incident or shutting off the water and turning it back on.




### **FOLLOW THESE 4 SIMPLE STEPS TO REDUCE FOG**
