

WATER VOLLEYBALL NEW PLAYER EVALUATION INFORMATION

<u>Purpose</u>: To provide players interested in joining the Divisional WVB Program the opportunity to be placed in an environment that best fits his/her playing ability. Evaluations will be used for the Divisional WVB program and any leagues, tournaments, or other related activities that are sponsored by the Division(s).

Where:

Evaluation sessions are held at Seabreeze Recreation Center Sports Pool (2384 Buena Vista Blvd)

When:

Evaluations for new or unrated players take place on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Seabreeze Recreation Center Sports Pool. Schedules may be adjusted for holidays, inclement weather, and during maintenance closures. Sessions are held from 3pm-4:50pm. Please arrive by 2:45pm to check in.

Checking in/Eligibility:

Please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. Participants will need to bring their Villages ID card and photo ID to verify age. Participants will sign a waiver of liability and VCDD Recreation Department Code of Conduct. Participants must be a Villages Resident or a Renter with valid ID 50 years of age or older.

It is recommended participants complete Water Volleyball 101 and 102 training or have 4 months experience playing before attending Evaluations.

Players that are currently rated may not participate. Please check with your Division for more information regarding participation and eligibility procedures.

How to Register:

Registration opens six days prior to each session at 8:30am and closes one day prior to the session at 4pm.

Register in person at any Regional Recreation Center Mon-Fri from 8:30am-4pm or online by accessing the Recreation <u>WVB Registration</u> page. You will need to sign in to register.

Once signed in search for WVB on the Activities page. Evaluation sessions are limited to 14 participants of each gender.
