Village Community Development Districts 1-11

If you live in Village Community Development Districts 1-11 in the Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, there will be no changes to the sanitation collection schedule on Friday, July 4, 2025.

Village Community Development Districts 12-15

If you live in Village Community Development District 12-15 of the Villages, there will be no changes to the sanitation collection schedule on Friday, July 4, 2025.

If you live in the **Lake County portion of the Villages** (not including VCDD No. 11 or 14), Friday collection will occur on Saturday.

If you live in the **Town of Lady Lake portion** of The Villages, Friday services will be performed on Tuesday, July 8, 2025.

If you live in the **Middleton Community Development District**, there will be no changes to the sanitation collection schedule.

Did you know coyotes are in every FL county?

Coyotes have been seen in our area but they rarely come in to contact with people. However, given the opportunity, they may prey upon unattended pets or livestock. Keep pets safe from interactions with coyotes and other wildlife:

- ·Walk dogs on a short (6-foot or less) leash and supervise them while outside, especially at night.
- ·Keep cats indoors. Keep in mind a screened porch is not secure from coyotes and other wildlife.
- ·Use electric fencing to protect small livestock such as chickens and goats.

Coyotes eat a wide variety of foods, including fruit, insects, rodents, and other small mammals, but will also eat garbage and pet food if given access. To discourage coyotes and other wildlife from lingering near your home, secure your trash, remove fallen fruit, and feed pets indoors. If you see a coyote nearby, you can scare it away by waving your arms in the air and yelling loudly. Noisemakers, like air horns, work too.
