

Paradise Recreation Center Groundbreaking

The Villages celebrated a historic milestone on August 28 with the groundbreaking of the new Paradise Recreation Center. The project will fully replace the original center, the first ever built in The Villages, with a modern facility offering a resort-style pool, expanded Mark Twain Library, game and arts rooms, shuffleboard courts, and scenic gathering spaces.

Construction is expected to take 18–22 months, with completion anticipated in late 2026 or early 2027. This revitalization honors the center's legacy while creating new opportunities for recreation and community connection.



Posting Guidelines for Community Info at Postal Stations

To help keep our postal stations neat, organized, and useful for all residents, the Community Development District has a few simple rules for submitting items for public posting.

Submission Requirements:

- Items must be no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (half-sheet of paper).
- Items will be posted for no more than 2 weeks.
- Each item may appear at up to 5 postal stations only.

What Cannot Be Posted:

To maintain a neutral and community-focused environment, please do not submit items related to:

- Commercial services or advertisements
- Charitable causes or organizations
- Religious content
- Club membership or recruitment
- Petitions
- Items/services for sale (including garage sales)
- Political materials
- Lost/found pets or personal belongings

You can submit your item in one of the following ways:

- Drop it off at the Customer Service Office
- Email it as an attachment to: customerservice@districtgov.org
- Place it in the utility/amenity box at any postal station

Please allow at least 3 business days for your item to be reviewed and posted. Thank you for helping us keep our community bulletin spaces clear, helpful, and respectful for all residents!

Keep wipes and other products from clogging your community's sewer system

To keep wastewater systems working properly, please flush only the appropriate waste down the toilet.

WIPES CLOG PIPES, SO REMEMBER THESE TIPS:

FLUSH IT:

Biological waste (urine, feces) and toilet paper are the only materials that should be flushed down the toilet. Toilet paper breaks down in water. Others products d not.

TRASH IT:

Paper towels, feminine hygiene products, wipes, and similar products must be disposed of as domestic waste and NOT flushed down the toilet.

These steps will help us keep collection and treatment systems operating properly. If there's no toilet paper and you must use something else, keep a trash bin in the bathroom to dispose of non-toilet-paper products. Clean the bin and surrounding areas regularly. Businesses should provide similar trash bins and consider posting signs reminding patrons not to flush non-toilet-paper products.

Please help us avoid unnecessary sewer clogs and backups.

Stay safer with MULTIFACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)

How to turn on MFA

MFA provides extra security for our online accounts and apps. This security could be a code sent via text or email or generated by an app, or biometrics like fingerprints and facial recognition. Using MFA confirms our identities when logging into our accounts.

Follow these easy steps on each account



Go to Settings

It may be called Account Settings, Settings & Privacy or similar.

Look for and turn on MFA

It may be called two-factor authentication, two-step verification or similar.

Confirm

Select how to provide extra login security, such as by entering a code sent via text or email or using facial recognition.

Congratulations!

After setting up MFA, logging in may require completing the MFA security step to prove our identities. It only takes a moment but makes us **significantly safer from malicious hackers!**
