Village Community Development Districts 1-11

If you live in Village Community Development Districts 1-11 in the Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, Thursday collection will occur on Saturday, December 27, 2025.

Friday collection will have normal services.

Village Community Development District No. 12 and the Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney, Thursday collection will occur on Saturday, December 27, 2025. Friday collection will have normal services.

Village Community Development District 13, (excluding Villages of DeLuna and Hammock at Fenney) and District 14 Thursday collection will occur on Saturday, December 27, 2025. Friday collection will have normal services

If you live in the **Lake County portion of The Villages** (not including VCDD No. 11 or 14), Thursday collection will occur on Friday. All remaining collection days for the week will be moved to the next day.

If you live in the **Town of Lady Lake portion of The Villages**, Thursday services will be performed on Friday, December 26, 2025.

Village Community Development District 15 (excluding Villages of Oak Hollow and Well Point) the Thursday pick up will be rescheduled to Saturday, December 27, 2025.

Districts 1-11

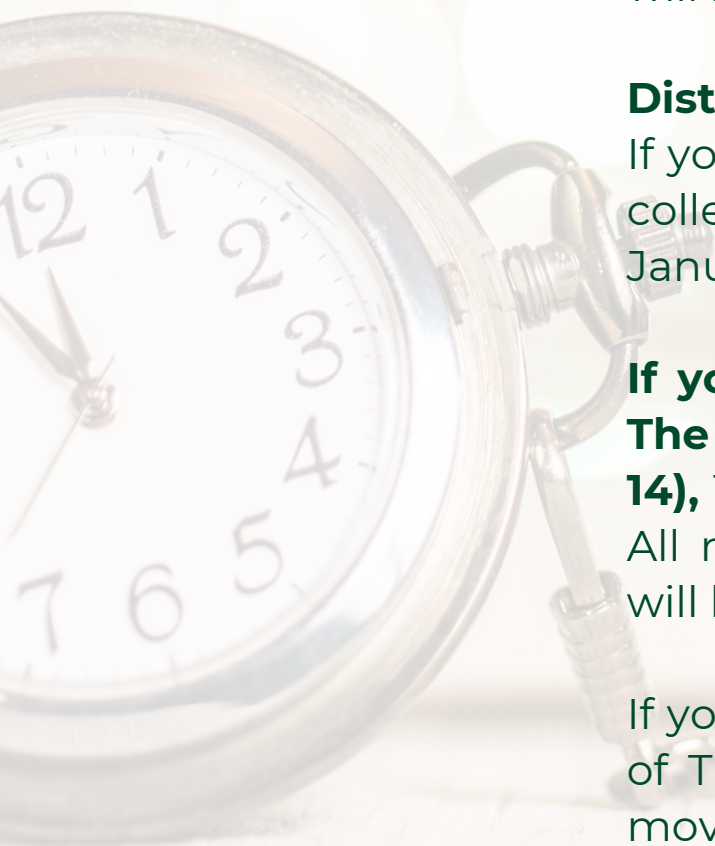
If you live in Village Community Development Districts 1-11 in the Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, Thursday collection will be moved to Saturday, January 3rd, 2026.

District 12, 13, 14 or 15

If you live in District 12, 13, 14, or 15, Thursday collection will be moved to Saturday, January 3rd, 2026.

If you live in the Lake County portion of The Villages (not including VCDD No. 11 or 14), Thursday collection will occur on Friday. All remaining collection days for the week will be moved to the next day.

If you live in the **Town of Lady Lake** portion of The Villages, Thursday collection will be moved to Monday, January 3rd, 2026.



CHRISTMAS TREE REMOVAL

Village Community Development Districts No. 1—No. 15

If you live in Districts 1-15 in the Sumter County, Marion County or Fruitland Park portions of The Villages, discarded live Christmas trees can be placed at the curb and will be collected with your regular household trash on your designated day. The trees must follow the procedures for yard waste. Tree limbs and branches may not exceed four (4) feet in length, four (4) inches in diameter or exceed 40 pounds.

Artificial trees should be taken apart and placed curb side in sections and will be collected with your regular household trash on your designated day. If you have any questions, please contact sanitation at 352-748-0109 (Districts 1-11) and 352-750-0000 for Districts 12-15.

If you live in the **Lake County portion of The Villages** (not including District No. 11), live trees can be placed at the curb on your assigned yard waste day and must be in 4' lengths and no more than 6" in diameter. To discard artificial trees, please call Lake County Solid Waste to schedule a bulk pick up at 352-343-3776.

If you live in the **Town of Lady Lake portion of The Villages**, live and artificial trees can be placed at the curb and will be collected with your regular household trash on your designated day. If you have any questions, please contact Waste Management at 352-787-4416.

Posting Guidelines for Community Info at Postal Stations

To help keep our postal stations neat, organized, and useful for all residents, the Community Development District has a few simple rules for submitting items for public posting.

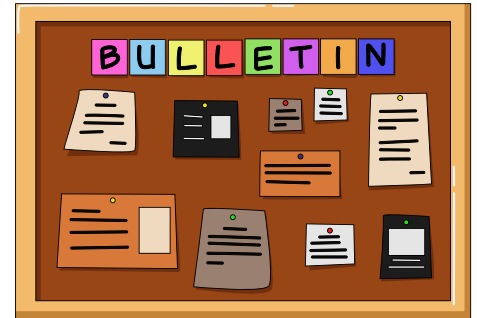
Submission Requirements:

- Items must be no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (half-sheet of paper).
- Items will be posted for no more than 2 weeks.
- Each item may appear at up to 5 postal stations only.

What Cannot Be Posted:

To maintain a neutral and community-focused environment, please do not submit items related to:

- Resident lifestyle groups or social clubs
- Commercial services or activities
- Charitable or religious materials
- Club recruitment/membership notices
- Petitions
- Items or services for sale, including garage sales
- Political materials supporting or opposing candidates or ballot measures
- Lost or found items/pets



How to Submit:

You can submit your item in one of the following ways:

- Drop it off at the Customer Service Office
- Email it as an attachment to: customerservice@districtgov.org
- Place it in the utility/amenity box at any postal station

Please allow at least 3 business days for your item to be reviewed and posted. Thank you for helping us keep our community bulletin spaces clear, helpful, and respectful for all residents!

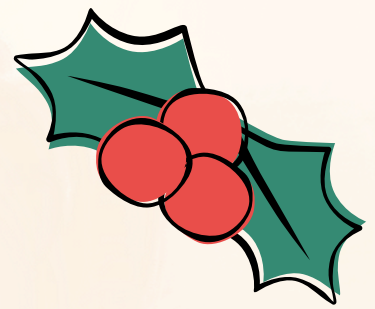

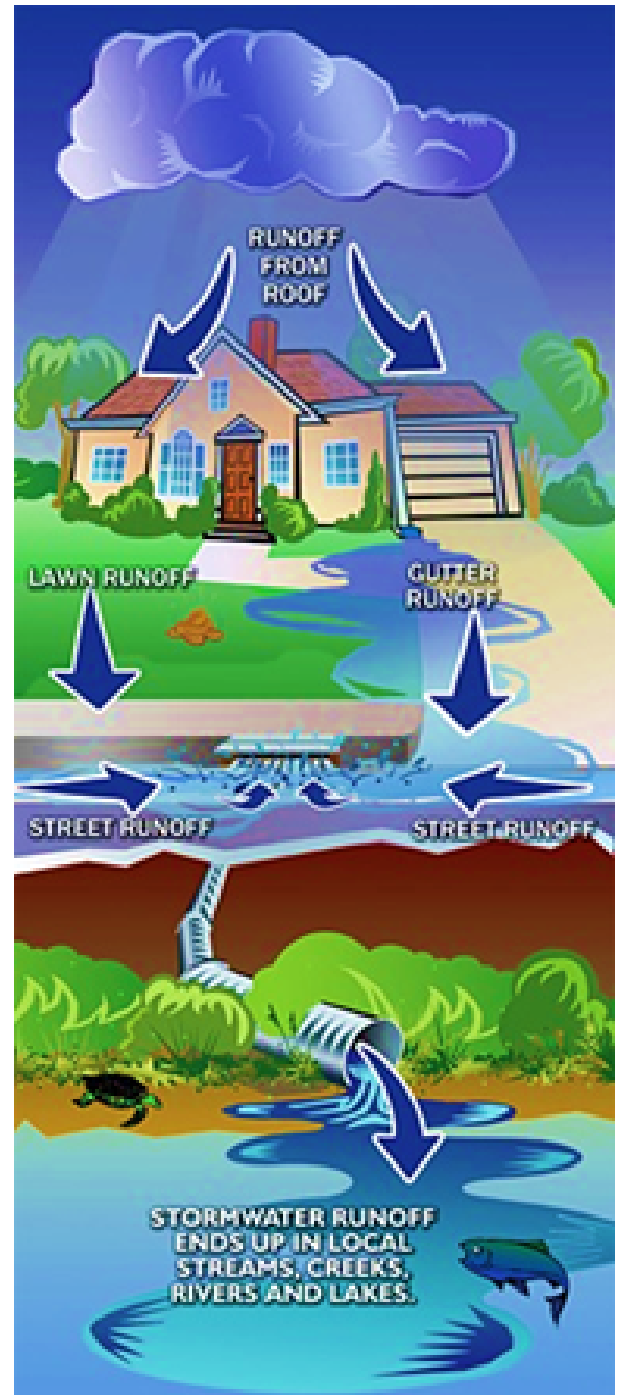


National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)

With the Villages growing each year, it is important for all of us to be aware of the environmental impacts daily actions can have on the areas around us. It is important that we are aware that our daily actions do not negatively affect the environment. The Villages community participates in the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit program or NPDES. This program is administered by the State of Florida through the Department of Environmental Protection and is required by the Federal Clean Water Act.

The District has a program and policy that prohibits illicit discharges of pollutants into our storm drain system and drainage basins. Some examples of these pollutants include oil, automotive fluids, paints, stains, pesticides, discarded or abandoned objects, and other liquid and solid wastes. It is important for our residents to become aware and educated so that they can help decrease or eliminate stormwater runoff pollution through preventative measures. There are many best practices that can be followed to help mitigate runoff pollution. Some examples are, but not limited to, recycle automotive fluids, minimize chemical applications near water bodies, compost yard waste, collect and properly dispose of pet waste, to name a few.

With everyone working together as a caring community, we can have a quality program to eliminate pollutants into the storm drainage system. With pollutant free ponds, lakes and wetlands, the wildlife and environment in which we co-inhabit can continue to be enjoyed for many years to come.

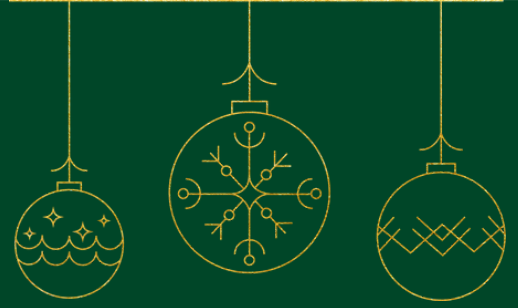
