Landscaping practices have evolved across the country, reflecting local climates and resources. Here in The Villages, we've embraced Florida-Friendly Landscaping as a practical way to maintain our community's distinctive appearance while conserving natural resources. Developed by the University of Florida's IFAS Extension, this approach encourages the use of plants well-suited to Florida's climate, soils, and rainfall.

Throughout The Villages, residents and community planners favor native and drought-tolerant plants, reducing the need for excess irrigation, fertilizers, and pesticides- while still creating attractive, well-maintained landscapes.

Water conservation is a key benefit of Florida-Friendly Landscaping. By grouping plants based on their water needs and using efficient irrigation systems, landscapes require less frequent watering and are better able to withstand dry periods.

Additional practices, such as rain sensors, proper mowing heights, and mulch, help retain soil moisture and reduce runoff. These steps not only lower water use but also help protect nearby lakes, ponds, and wetlands from nutrient pollution.

Florida-Friendly Landscaping also supports the long-term sustainability of our community. Healthier soils, increased wildlife habitat, and reduced maintenance demands contribute to a more resilient, enjoyable landscape. By adopting these practices throughout The Villages, we show how a large residential community can balance growth, beauty, and environmental responsibility- serving as an example for other Florida communities.

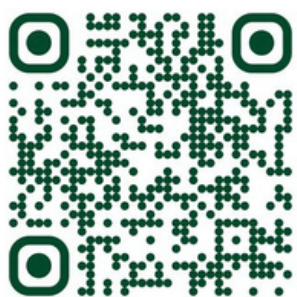

The following items can be placed in your regular household waste pick-up:

- Lamps
- Plastic Chairs
- Ceiling fans (blades must be removed)
- Brooms
- Pallets
- Carpeting and/or padding (No larger than 4' x 4' & less than 40 lbs.)

A Bulk Item Pick-Up will need to be scheduled for larger items such as:

- Microwaves and small kitchen appliances
- Office chairs/desk chairs/kitchen chairs
- 2-burner grills
- Flat-screen TVs
- Ironing boards
- Electronics (computers, stereo equipment, monitors etc.)
