

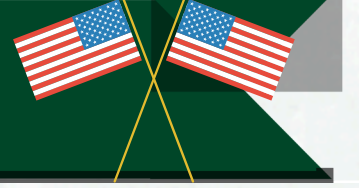

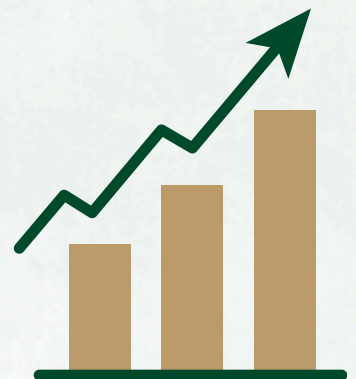

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT UPDATE

Due to ongoing dry conditions, the Southwest Florida Water Management District has issued a Modified Phase III Water Shortage Order for The Villages, that started on **April 3** and continues **through July 1, 2026**.

Key Points for Residents

- Watering is limited to once per week on your assigned day. (see chart below)
- Allowed watering times:
 - 12:01 a.m.–4:00 a.m. or 8:00 p.m.–11:59 p.m.
 - *homes under 1 acre pick one watering window.*
- Hand watering and plants: Any day before 8 a.m. or after 6 p.m.
- Car washing at home: Only on your watering day with a shut-off nozzle.
- Fountains and decorative features: May run up to 4 hours per day.
- Pressure washing: Only for necessary purposes (e.g., preparing for painting).

Updated watering rules start tomorrow, please plan accordingly and help conserve our water resources.

WATERING DAYS ARE BASED ON THIS SCHEDULE FOR ADDRESSES ENDING IN:

0 or 1 ▶ shall only water on **MONDAY**

2 or 3 ▶ on **TUESDAY**

4 or 5 ▶ on **WEDNESDAY**

6 or 7 ▶ on **THURSDAY**

8 or 9* ▶ on **FRIDAY**

*along with locations with a mix of addresses or for which an address cannot be determined (such as common areas associated with a subdivision)

NEW: Unless your city or county already has stricter hours in effect

Properties under one acre in size may only water before 4 a.m. or after 8 p.m. (must choose one)

Properties one acre or larger may only water before 4 a.m. and after 8 p.m.

Wildwood Begins Barwick Street Improvements Project

The City of Wildwood has begun construction on an improvements project along Barwick Street between Warfield Avenue and St. Clair Street, with additional work near Osceola Avenue.

The project encompasses roadway reconstruction, drainage improvements, utility upgrades, and restoration work, all while preserving historical oak trees in medians wherever possible. “This area has experienced drainage and flooding concerns, particularly after heavy rainfall,” said Public Works Director Jeremy Hockenbury. “We are addressing these localized challenges throughout the city systematically, neighborhood by neighborhood. I’m thrilled our contractor was available to begin so quickly on this one.”

Work began this week and is expected to take approximately nine months. Improvements are designed to reduce standing water on roads and in yards, augment stormwater collection and drainage, upgrade underground utilities, and strengthen the roadway to extend its lifespan.

Motorists are advised to allow additional time and use caution when traveling through the area. The public can expect delays, temporary lane and/or road closures, possible detours, heavy equipment, and construction personnel. Residents in work zones will have access to their properties at all times.

STAY READY: Fuel Up for Hurricane Season

The Florida Department of Emergency Management's "Halfway Full, Halfway There" [campaign](#) is a simple reminder to stay prepared as hurricane season begins.

Keep your vehicle's fuel tank at least half full at all times during storm season. This helps ensure you can evacuate quickly if needed and avoid long fuel lines or shortages. For electric vehicles, keep your battery charged between 50–80%, following manufacturer guidance.

Why it matters

When storms approach, fuel demand rises quickly. Staying at least halfway ready helps you:

- Evacuate faster if needed
- Avoid fuel shortages
- Reduce last-minute stress

Be prepared ahead of time

Know your evacuation zone, plan where you would go, and stay tuned to official updates.

EXECUTIVE GOLF MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Summer is here, bringing the familiar Florida heat, humidity, and afternoon thunderstorms that keep our Executive Golf Maintenance team hard at work each day. From clearing storm debris and keeping drains flowing properly to mowing rapidly growing turf, our crews are focused on maintaining excellent playing conditions across our courses.

Following another extremely busy winter season, our focus has shifted toward important renovation and improvement projects designed to preserve the long-term quality of our executive golf experience. Rest and Rehab closures are currently scheduled for courses including Volusia and Hawkes Bay, allowing crews to complete essential maintenance such as aerification, weed control treatments, concrete repairs, tree trimming, painting, and restroom flooring upgrades.

Several larger capital improvement projects are also underway. At El Santiago, crews are completing the installation of new gravel and preparing for soil placement on the greens. El Diablo is scheduled to close for renovations beginning **May 12**. Following the start of work at El Diablo, renovations at Redfish Run and Roosevelt are expected to begin shortly afterward. Updates and anticipated reopening timelines will continue to be shared as projects progress, check our [website](#) for updates.

As we move into hurricane and tropical storm season, weather remains one of the biggest challenges for golf course operations. Heavy rain and strong winds can cause flooding, course damage, and cleanup efforts that may take several days - or longer following major storms. We appreciate your patience and understanding as our maintenance teams work diligently to restore course conditions as quickly and safely as possible. 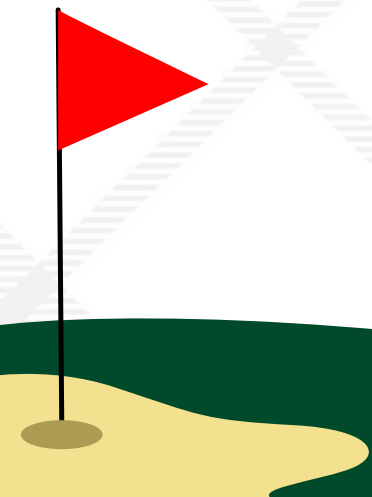

To keep wastewater systems working properly, please flush only the appropriate waste down the toilet.

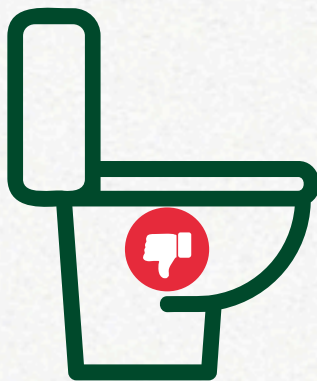
WIPES CLOG PIPES, SO REMEMBER THESE TIPS:

FLUSH IT:

Biological waste (urine, feces) and toilet paper are the only materials that should be flushed down the toilet. Toilet paper breaks down in water. Other products do not.

TRASH IT:

Paper towels, feminine hygiene products, wipes, and similar products must be disposed of as domestic waste and NOT flushed down the toilet.

These steps will help us keep collection and treatment systems operating properly. If there's no toilet paper and you must use something else, keep a trash bin in the bathroom to dispose of non-toilet-paper products. Clean the bin and surrounding areas regularly. Businesses should provide similar trash bins and consider posting signs reminding patrons not to flush non-toilet-paper products.

Please help us avoid unnecessary sewer clogs and backups.
