Phase III Water Shortage for Lake County and District 14

As irrigation guidelines continue to evolve, residents are encouraged to regularly visit the [What's Happening](#) page on the District's website for updates on the Phase III Water Shortage.

Residents in portions of Lake County are now under a Phase III Water Shortage Order issued by the St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD), while neighboring areas continue operating under restrictions from the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD).

According to local officials, the SJRWMD restrictions are less restrictive than the current Modified Phase III order enforced by SWFWMD. Under the updated SJRWMD guidelines, irrigation is permitted before 8 a.m. and after 6 p.m. In contrast, SWFWMD regulations continue to allow irrigation only before 4 a.m. and after 8 p.m.

Updated guidance has been posted to [Water Wisdom University](#), including area-specific information for customers and districts operating under SJRWMD jurisdiction. Officials noted that VCSA customers and District 14 fall under the SJRWMD order, while District 11 remains subject to SWFWMD restrictions because its wells are located in Sumter County.

Resident Out of Area Program

The Resident Out of Area Program is a complimentary service offered by Community Watch to all residents of The Villages who will be away from their home for more than seven days. This program is designed to enhance resident safety and support emergency operations during major weather events and other large-scale incidents.

When enrolled, Community Watch will notify you if your home sustains visible damage during a natural disaster, such as a hurricane, tornado, severe storm, or similar emergency affecting the community. Community Watch works closely with VPSD in a coordinated effort to provide added peace of mind to residents while also creating operational efficiencies across District departments for the benefit of the community.

This early notification allows you to take appropriate action while enabling emergency responders to focus their efforts on occupied residences, where life-safety risks are greatest.

- By identifying which homes are unoccupied, the program helps emergency personnel prioritize rescue operations and allocate resources more efficiently during critical incidents. This alignment of information and response is believed to contribute to saving lives, reducing confusion, and improving overall disaster-response effectiveness.

Participation is free, easy, and strongly encouraged for any resident planning to travel, especially those travelling to a location where contact is difficult, such as on a cruise. Resident Out of Area is a timesaver in many different ways.

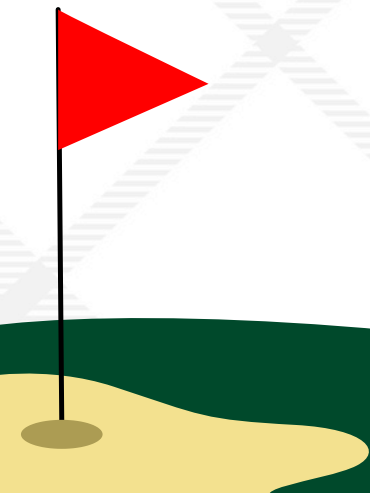

HOW TO REQUEST A RECREATION ACCOMMODATION

Bulletin Boards

The bulletin boards located at the postal stations are a great way for residents to see information from the District or learn about local events being held by their neighborhood social groups.

Flyers must be submitted to Customer Service by email (customerservice@districtgov.org) or in person at one of our three locations. The submission must include the resident's name, contact information and which postal stations the resident wishes to post it at (may not exceed 5 stations). Flyers can be no larger than 5.5" by 8.5".

What is not allowed to be posted:

- Religious material
- Lifestyle Social Clubs
- Petitions / political items
- Items for sale / Garage sales
