

RESOLUTION 2026-06

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE WILDWOOD UTILITY DEPENDENT DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2026, South Sumter Utility Master Lift Station No. 28 experienced a power outage and emergency generator failure, resulting in an inability to maintain normal sanitary sewer flow operations.; and,

WHEREAS, on March 10th Resolution 2026-03 was presented to the board of supervisors for the total amount of \$500,000 to cover six residential homes, necessitating the temporary emergency displacement of residents, the remediation and minor interior demolition, as well as interior restoration services to return the affected residential structures to pre-existing condition; and,

WHEREAS, Additional funding in the amount of \$200,000 is needed for residential repairs, displacement-related housing reimbursements, replacement of damaged contents, and costs associated with the ongoing generator failure investigation, including emergency generator rental, replacement parts, and specialized technical support.

WHEREAS, the request to amend the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Budget has been reviewed and approved by the District Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WILDWOOD UTILITY DEPENDENT DISTRICT THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 BUDGET BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

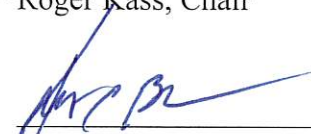
